The BOR consists of the Executive Committee and three standing committees...Academic and Student Affairs, University Advancement and Administration and Finance. These are short features, captured in personal or comfortable settings – just an exceptional person and their favorite story in hand. We take a look back at the storm, its aftermath and the city's response. The world watched as thousands of people lost their homes and property. We will evaluate questions including: 'How has the city changed?', 'What lessons were learned?', and 'Where did the relief morey go?'. Whit the help from the news department, and in conjunction with the hurricane podcast series, IPM will oversee the production of a series of stories addressing those questions.
